

Visit Chislehurst Christmas Market is a community event which takes place in a high street.

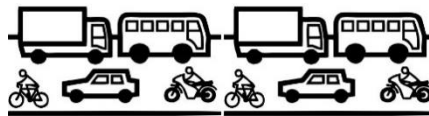
There will be music to listen to.



There will be Santa's Grotto, a sleigh and reindeer. There will be a quiet hour between 10am and 11am.

There will be stalls with gifts, food and a bar.

You can come to the Christmas Market by car, bus, train or bike. There may be lots of other people arriving at the same time so you might have to wait in a queue for a few minutes.



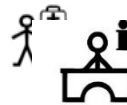
When you arrive there will be people in brightly coloured jackets called stewards who will help you.



If you are feeling anxious, our stewards can help you.



If you need any information you can go to the Information point or if you are feeling unwell you can go to the first aid point.



If you don't like loud or sudden noises, you may want to bring some headphones with you. You may also need water, sun cream or waterproofs, depending on the weather.



The event is mostly outside so please wear something warm.



There are accessible toilets and there will be signs pointing them out.

You can arrive at the Christmas Market any time after 11am and it finishes at 5pm, when it will be dark.
